1. If you believe in Jesus, you will do the same works/ miracles He did
2. Not only that, but you will do "greater works" than these

*He will do what we ask to bring Glory to the Father
4. If we love Him, we will keep His commands
5. He will manifest Himself to us

TRIALS - James 1:2-8

Count it all joy. The testing of our faith produces patience

Let patience produce its perfect work. Ask God for wisdom

God gives liberally and without reproach

HOWEVER, if you ask, ask in faith, with NO DOUBTING!

He who doubts is like a wave of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind.

You can't receive anything from God if you pray that way.

We all have seasons of faith and seasons of doubt. Many of us have seen miracle healings, financial provision, and supernatural deliverance. Just because we have received it in the past does not mean we are currently operating in the faith required to receive it now. Because we have seen God manifest before, we assume we have the faith in that moment to receive from God again. We may even get offended if our faith is mentioned or questioned. When God's word appears to not be working for us in that circumstance, it can cause some to question God and His Word. Some may even turn away from God.

The problem does not lie with God's ability or His desire to heal or provide for us. He is always willing and able. The problem always lies with our faith. Even if it is a question of God's timing, it still is a question of our faith. Is our faith strong enough to continue to praise Him in the storm, and to wait on God until the breakthrough comes?

We cannot live off of the faith of a previous season to get us through today's trial. This is why it is so important to spend daily time in prayer and in the word. We must get fresh manna from Heaven to sustain us through every new season and trial. It can be so hard to press in to God during a new season of wilderness or struggle, but this is when it is most important.

James 1:5 says we must ask God for wisdom. When you find yourself in a trial, seek God, and ask Him how to respond. Ask Him how he sees it, and how you should perceive it.

I have seen battle tested saints, who received monumental miracles in the past, seemingly give up; just roll over and take whatever the enemy gives them. I have been through this myself. I have seen cancer healed in others. I have been healed myself of a ruptured appendix, broken ankle, Fibromyalgia, Endometriosis, etc. Yet I continued, after these miracles, to struggle with back pain, migraines, a torn labrum in my pelvis, etc. The enemy tried to put Fibromyalgia back on me a few years back. At first, I just accepted it. Then I realized I had just given in, and I began to war against it. I was also plagued by occasional fear and depression.

During these times of weakness when I was allowing the enemy to have victory over me, there were other faith filled people speaking healing over me. They tried to hold me accountable and not allow me to speak the enemy's words or plans over myself or my family. Even though they were speaking the Word of God over me or the situation, it was sometimes very offensive. I wanted to be perceived as full of faith. But the truth was, I was not currently operating in faith and I needed to be corrected. I needed to be reminded.

Hebrews 4:12 – The word of God is quick, powerful, sharper than a 2-edged sword, piercing, dividing soul and spirit. It is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

If your words, your thoughts, your actions do not line up with GOD's WORD, then when others speak HIS WORD to you, it will seem offensive.

Matt. 11:6 – Blessed is he who is not offended in Me.

Matt. 13:53-58 – The people in Nazareth rejected Jesus. They said "Isn't this the carpenter's son?" They were offended at Him. "A prophet is without honor in his own land/house."

In the early 2000's I got offended at God. I had been in a wheelchair from a car accident. I turned to the Lord. I asked God to heal me. I did not understand all these principles, and healing did not manifest. I got offended at God and turned back to my old ways. I was worse off than I was before (Matt 12:43-45).

Acts 16 – Paul and Silas in Philippi

They were thrown in jail for preaching the gospel and performing miracles.

After being beaten, they praised God at midnight behind bars. As they sang and praised, the prison doors were opened. Because they were willing to praise God through their suffering, the entire family of the jailer was saved!

How many times do we complain through our trial, and miss an opportunity to win souls?!?

If we murmur and complain, we miss God's plan in the trial. Did God cause the trial? No, satan did. If we refuse to praise Him in the storm, we miss the chance to bring God glory! He can't turn our mourning into dancing, remove our rags and clothe us w gladness if we refuse to trust Him.

The ROOT of murmuring and complaining is a LACK OF FAITH!

It is an inability to trust God and His word. A refusal to obey him. At the very core of sickness and oppression is REBELLION! Why is it rebellion? Because anything that is not of faith is sin (Romans 14:23). It is Rebellion because we already know what the Word of God says, but we refuse to believe or obey it, and thus, get offended when pressure comes. However, great peace have they that love His law, and nothing can offend them (Psalm 119:165). There are certain spiritual laws at play, and we must abide by them if we want the Word of God to perform for us. When we don't obey those laws, we are in rebellion. This all goes back to our words! Death and life are in the power of the tongue! (Prov. 18:21)

Kenneth E. Hagin quote:

"A lot of people don't want to get rid of their worries (or ailments). They claim they do, but they really don't. If they got rid of them, they wouldn't have any reason for people to sympathize with them. They wouldn't have anything to talk about. They would have to cease conversation entirely!"

Philippians 4:6

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God"

1 Peter 5:6,7

"Therefore, humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you."

The Lord has already given you clear instruction. Are you refusing to cast your care upon Him? Do you feel that the blood He shed is just not enough for your problems? This is preposterous! If we obey God, we refuse to worry. We will stop spewing our anxiety on everyone else and we will cast our cares upon the Lord. We will begin to praise Him for changing things, long before we see the manifestation of it. If we can't bring ourselves to praise Him when things look bad, then the devil has already won!

I never quite made the connection between Isaiah 53, and my emotions and thought life. Jesus paid the price so I can be saved, healed AND delivered!!!! To walk in depression, anxiety, worry or torment of any kind is not God's will or plan. Just the same as we must resist the devil and any symptoms to walk in physical healing, we must also resist any thoughts or emotions that are from the enemy so we can walk in mental and emotional health.

I am finally starting to see deliverance for emotional and mental issues the same as physical healing. Its already bought and paid for! The blood of Jesus really is enough! No matter what circumstances, attacks, or warfare that comes, we MUST resist the enemy!
