## The Basics

The greatest weapon against the devil is to speak and declare God's word regarding that situation. Jesus used the word of God when the devil tempted Him in the wilderness, saying "It is written." **Matthew 4:1-11**

Prayers are always more powerful than we may realize, but the most effective way to pray is to speak and declare God's Word because HIS word will never return void or ineffective. This also includes the prophetic word spoken by His people today. When the Lord speaks through us, His words will not return void. But we must not take lightly the power in speaking and praying His written Word. The written Word is already established and can be trusted as the genuine voice of God.

"Lord, the word that goes out from your mouth will not return to you void. It shall accomplish that which pleases You and it will prosper in the thing You sent it to do." **Isaiah 55:11**

## Healing and Forgiveness of Sins

Many think that forgiveness of sins and physical or emotional healing are two separate things. Scriptures say they are not separate, but rather that they go hand in hand. When Christ forgave your sins, he simultaneously provided healing for you. You cannot separate healing from salvation. It's a package deal.

Lord you bore all my grief and carried my sorrows. You were wounded for my transgressions and You were bruised for my iniquities. The chastisement that was upon you makes peace available to me. And by Your stripes (the wounds inflicted upon you when you died for me,) I was healed over 2000 years ago.

**Isaiah 53:4-5**

I bless you Lord, oh my soul and will not forget all of your benefits. You forgive all my sins, You heal all my diseases, You redeem my life from destruction, and You crown my head with loving kindness and tender mercies. You satisfy my mouth with good things so that my youth is renewed like the Eagles. **Psalm 103:2-5**

I will serve the Lord my God and He will bless my bread and my water. He will take sickness away from my midst. **Exodus 23:25**

The Spirit of God that raised Jesus from the dead dwells in me. God, who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to my mortal body through His Spirit who dwells in me. **Romans 8:11**

For what credit is it if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this is commendable before God. For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: “Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth”; who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously; who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

## Fruit of the Spirit

## Authority and Spiritual Warfare

The enemy may try to steal, kill and destroy, but Jesus came that I may have life, and that I might have it more abundantly. **John 10:10**

No weapon formed against me shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against me in judgment, I shall condemn. This *is* my inheritance as a Saint, and my righteousness *is* from God, says the Lord. **Isaiah 54:17**

Lord, I reject death and curses. I choose life and blessings, so that I and my seed shall live. **Deut. 30:19**

Lord I thank you that you have given me power and authority to drive out demons and to cure diseases. **Luke 9:1**

Lord, I submit myself to you. Help me to resist the devil so that he will flee from me. **James 4:7**

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled. **2 Corinth. 10:3-6**

My struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against rulers and authorities, against powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the supernatural realms. **Ephesh. 6:12**

Thank You Lord that you have given me the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt me. I do not rejoice that the spirits are subject to me, but rather I rejoice because my name is written in the Book of Life. **Luke 10:19**

I thank you Lord that You prepare a table in the presence of my enemies. I thank you Lord that even in the midst of spiritual warfare, I can fellowship with you in intimacy. I will enjoy your presence, even when the enemy is near. **Psalms 23:5**

“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives even unto death.” **Revelation 12:11**

## Protection

I will dwell in the secret place of the Most High and I will abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the LORD, “He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.” Surely He shall deliver me (and my family) from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence. He shall cover me (and my family) with His feathers, and under His wings I shall take refuge; His truth shall be my shield and buckler. I shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at my side, and ten thousand at my right hand; but it shall not come near me (or my family). Only with my eyes shall I look, and see the reward of the wicked. Because I have made the LORD, who is my refuge, even the Most High, my dwelling place, no evil shall befall me (or my family), nor shall any plague come near my dwelling; For He shall give His angels charge over me, to keep me in all my ways. The angels will lift me (and my family) up in their hands, so that I won’t even dash my foot against a stone. I shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent I shall trample underfoot. The Lord says, “Because you have set your love upon Me, therefore I will deliver you; I will set you on high, because you have known My name. You shall call upon Me, and I will answer you; I will be with you in trouble; I will deliver you and honor you. With long life I will satisfy you, and show you My salvation.” **Psalms 91:1-16**

## Deliverance and Binding evil Spirits

Not everyone has the authority to cast out demons. This authority comes from an intimate relationship with Christ Jesus; not just knowing things “about God,” but actually having a one on one interaction with Him on a consistent basis.

These are just a few circumstances that STOP us from casting demons out of a person or home:

- The person does not intend on following God after deliverance (doesn't really want to be free or is not fully committed to the Lord in prayer and lifestyle).
- A praying wife wants her home prayed over, but her husband does not follow God and allows a door to be opened for demonic forces to reside in that home.

**Any believer in Christ who knows how to operate in Christ's authority can command demons to get out of their personal space. You have the right to cast demons off of yourself for some of these purposes:**

- To cast out infirmity spirits when you are sick.
- To cast out tormenting spirits when they invade your thoughts.
- To cast out demons who cause strongholds of sin in your life.

**If the conditions are right, and you believe you have authority in a situation to cast demons out, thus commanding them to leave, this is one example of how to word it.**

"In the name of Jesus, I command the Spirit of \_\_\_\_\_ to go, to leave me, to get out of my life (my body, my house, my child, etc.). In the name of Jesus, I bind your works and your strategies from hindering me with \_\_\_\_\_ (fear, lust, anger, etc). I command you to go now, in Jesus' name! I plead the blood of Jesus over me, and I declare that greater is Christ in me than the devil who is in the world. Because I am a child of God, the evil one has no legal rights to me or my family."

**If there is a person allowing an evil spirit to be in your home, you cannot cast it out, but you can bind it.**

"In the name of Jesus, I bind the Spirit of \_\_\_\_\_, and I command you to be still and to be silent. You have no legal right to me or my family and in the name of Jesus you cannot influence, torment, or effect me in any way."

**If you are longing to see a change in a loved one or acquaintance, prayer can be very effective. Not only can you bind spirits from being able to effect you, but you can also bind demons from operating on or through those around you.**

"In the name of Jesus, I bind the spirit of \_\_\_\_\_, and I command you not to operate on, around or through \_\_\_\_\_ (the person you are praying for). I prophecy complete healing and deliverance in this area. I trust you God that you are delivering them."

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound. **Isaiah 61:1**

A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and you shall keep my judgments, and do them.

**Ezekiel 36:26-27**

## **Fasting acceptable to the Lord for Healing and Deliverance**

### **Isaiah 58**

“Cry aloud, spare not; Lift up your voice like a trumpet; Tell My people their transgression, And the house of Jacob their sins. [2] Yet they seek Me daily, And delight to know My ways, As a nation that did righteousness, And did not forsake the ordinance of their God. They ask of Me the ordinances of justice; They take delight in approaching God. [3] ‘Why have we fasted,’ they say, ‘and You have not seen? Why have we afflicted our souls, and You take no notice?’ “In fact, in the day of your fast you find pleasure, And exploit all your laborers. [4] Indeed you fast for strife and debate, And to strike with the fist of wickedness. You will not fast as you do this day, To make your voice heard on high. [5] Is it a fast that I have chosen, A day for a man to afflict his soul? Is it to bow down his head like a bulrush, And to spread out sackcloth and ashes? Would you call this a fast, And an acceptable day to the LORD? [6] “Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, To undo the heavy burdens, To let the oppressed go free, And that you break every yoke? [7] Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, And that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out; When you see the naked, that you cover him, And not hide yourself from your own flesh? [8] *Then your light shall break forth like the morning, Your healing shall spring forth speedily, And your righteousness shall go before you; The glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard. [9] Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer; You shall cry, and He will say, ‘Here I am.’ ‘If you take away the yoke from your midst, The pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, [10] If you extend your soul to the hungry And satisfy the afflicted soul, Then your light shall dawn in the darkness, And your darkness shall be as the noonday. [11] The LORD will guide you continually, And satisfy your soul in drought, And strengthen your bones; You shall be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. [12] Those from among you Shall build the old waste places; You shall raise up the foundations of many generations; And you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, The Restorer of Streets to Dwell In. [13] “If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, From doing your pleasure on My holy day, And call the Sabbath a delight, The holy day of the LORD honorable, And shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, Nor finding your own pleasure, Nor speaking your own words,[14] Then you shall delight yourself in the LORD; And I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, And feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. ## The Christ-like Husband (for husbands to read)

(Male) My wife is a fruitful vine in the very heart of my house, my children like olive plants all around my table. **Psalms 128:3**

(Male) Lord, I pray I will make it easy for my wife to submit to my leadership, as she does to the Lord. For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, let her trust my decisions. Lord, teach me how to love my wife, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her. Teach me how to sacrifice my wants and needs for hers. Lord, teach me how to sanctify and cleanse my wife by reading the Word of God to her, that I might present her to God, a glorious bride, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. Help me to love my wife as much as I love my own body; because he who loves his wife loves himself. **Ephesians 5:22-28**

(Male) Lord help me to dwell with my wife with understanding, giving honor to her as to the weaker vessel. Help me to treat her as an equal. Help me treat her well so that my prayers may not be hindered. I thank you Lord that my wife and I are of one mind, having compassion for one another, being tenderhearted, and courteous. We will not return evil for evil or insult for insult. On the contrary we will return a blessing, knowing that we were called to this, that we may inherit a blessing. **1 Peter 3:7-9**

But we urge you, brethren, that you increase more and more (in love); that you also aspire to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you, that you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that you may lack nothing. **1 Thessalonians 4:10b-12**

But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever. **1 Timothy 5:8**

## The Virtuous Wife (for wives to read)

(Female) I am a virtuous wife. My worth *is* far above rubies. The heart of my husband safely trusts me; he will have no lack of gain. I will do him good and not evil all the days of my life. I willingly work with my hands and serve my household. I will arise while it is yet night, and make preparations for my household. When asked to, I will make financial decisions for our house. I gird myself with strength, and strengthen my arms. My lamp does not go out by night. I will extend my hand to the poor, I will reach out my hands to the needy. I will not be afraid of the seasons or the circumstances because I know I am prepared. My husband will be known in the city and I will always speak well of him. Strength and honor *are* my clothing and I shall rejoice in time to come. I open my mouth with wisdom, and on my tongue *is* the law of kindness. I will watch over the ways of my household, and will not eat the bread of idleness. My children will rise up and call me blessed; my husband *also*, and he praises me: “Many daughters have done well, But you excel them all.” Charm *is* deceitful and beauty *is* passing, but I will be a woman *who* fears the Lord. **Proverbs 31:10-30**

(Female) I will be like a fruitful vine, in the very heart of my house, my children like olive plants, all around my table. **Psalms 128:3**

(Female) Lord, I choose to submit to my husband, as to the Lord. For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, I will be subject to my own husband in everything. I thank you Lord that my husband loves me, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her. I thank you Lord that my husband sanctifies and cleanses me with the washing of water by the Word of God, that He might present me to God, a glorious bride, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that I should be holy and without blemish. I thank you Lord that my husband loves me as his own body; because he who loves his wife loves himself. **Ephesians 5:22-28**

(Female) I choose to be submissive to my husband, even if he does not obey the Word of God or makes a bad decision. I pray, that without saying a word, I may win his heart for God by my good conduct, when my husband observes my chaste (self-controlled) conduct *accompanied* by (a healthy) fear (of the Lord). I will not let my adornment be *merely* outward—arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on *fine* apparel— but rather I will let my adornments *be* the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible *beauty* of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God. For in this manner, in former times, the holy women who trusted in God also adorned themselves, being submissive to their own husbands, as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, whose daughter I am if I do good and am not afraid with any terror. I thank you Lord that my husband dwells with me with understanding, giving honor to me, as to the weaker vessel, and as *being* heirs together of the grace of life, that his prayers may not be hindered. I thank you Lord that my husband and I are of one mind, having compassion for one another, being tenderhearted, and courteous. We will not return evil for evil or insult for insult. On the contrary we will return a blessing, knowing that we were called to this, that we may inherit a blessing. **1 Peter 3:1-9**

## Faith

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. I have faith that my prayers are being answered and that God is already changing things, even if I can't see the change yet. **Hebrews 11:1**

So Jesus answered and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' it will be done. "And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive."

**Matthew 21:21-22**

Wherever He entered, into villages, cities, or the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched Him were made well.
